The **Leaders in Training (LIT) Program** at Camp Ke-Mon-Oya offers students the opportunity to earn a **Grade 11 Physical Education credit: *Healthy Living and Outdoor Activities (PAD30)*** while participating in the camp experience. This program, in cooperation with North Toronto Christian School, blends leadership development with experiential learning in an outdoor setting. The cost of this program is \$740.00.

Through hands-on involvement in camp activities, students will build practical leadership skills while exploring topics such as personal fitness, healthy living, outdoor recreation, teamwork, and risk management. Participants will take part in activities such as hiking, canoeing, land-based education, cooperative games, and camp leadership training, all while reflecting on how healthy lifestyle choices support physical, mental, and spiritual well-being.

The PAD30 credit recognizes the valuable learning that already takes place in the LIT experience and provides students with an opportunity to apply leadership in real-life settings while earning an Ontario secondary school credit. This program is ideal for students who enjoy the outdoors, want to develop their leadership skills, and are interested in learning how healthy living and active lifestyles can positively shape their lives and the communities around them.

To apply for the LIT program, you must be entering Grade 11 in September 2026. The program will run for three weeks (during Junior camp) starting July 6 and concluding on

July 24 with a weekend canoe trip. Transportation to and from the camp is provided on Monday mornings and Friday afternoons from North Toronto Christian School in North York. For the first two weeks, the program will consist of Bible study, leadership seminars, activity training and helping out in various ways around the camp. For the third and last week, LITs will be a junior counsellor in a cabin and assist with activities as determined by the camp director and their senior, supervising counsellor.


